## 2017/18

Three easy steps for your garden waste collection...

1.

Place your garden waste loose in your brown bin.

2.

Place your bin at the boundary to your property by 6.30am on your collection day.

3.

Please return the bin to your property once it has been emptied.

- \* Any additional rubbish placed beside your bin will not be taken (except real Christmas trees).
- \* Whilst we make every effort to empty your bin, garden waste that is stuck, frozen or contaminated may not be collected.

Kitchen waste (including fruit and veg peelings)  
Flower pots  
Straw, sawdust or other used for pet bedding or gardening  
Over full bins  
Bin lids open
