Breckland Council is offering grants for community groups wishing to hold events as part of the 'The Great Get Together'. This is a one-off grant scheme for up to £200.

The grant is supporting getting together with your neighbours and celebrating what we have in common. Applicants for the grant must agree to hold a Great Get Together event on 17-18 June 2017.

The weekend marks the anniversary of the murder of Jo Cox MP who inspired many when she said we had more in common than divides us. Find more here; www.greatgettogether.org

Who can apply?

Any groups in Breckland that are constituted and have a bank account are eligible to apply such as parish councils, sports clubs, women's institutes, and social groups. Applications from groups working collaboratively will be looked upon more favourably as well as those who bringing new groups of residents together.

What qualifies as a 'The Great Get Together'?

Your event could be big or small, indoors or out, it's entirely up to you. It could be a street party, a barbecue, an afternoon tea or any other food related get together. Whatever you and your neighbours decide your event must run on either 17-18 June 2017, as it is part of a national celebration of what we have in common.

What can be funded?

The grant can go towards activities, entertainment, equipment hire, venue hire, decorations, food and drink.

What do I need to do to apply?

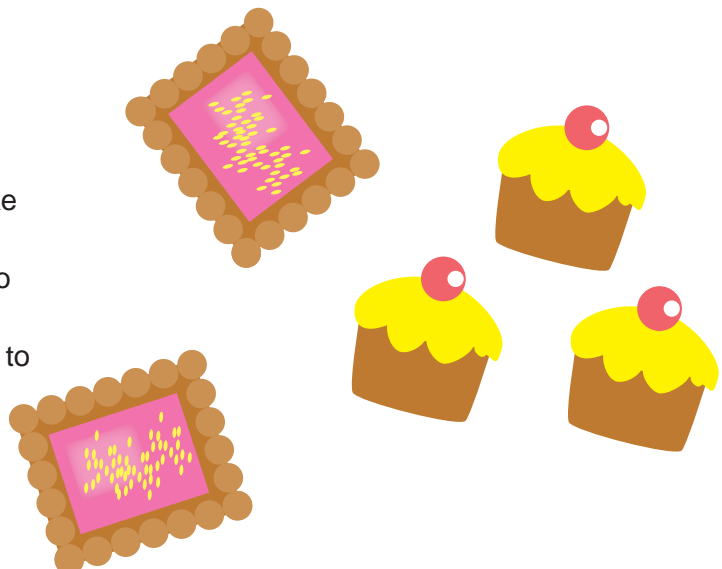
- Decide when and where your event will take place.
- Decide how much money to apply for (up to £200) and what to spend it on.
- Complete the Application Form and send it to us.

Deadline for the Application

The deadline for all applications is **2 May 2017**. A decision will be made by 5 May 2017. We may need to ask you further questions about your application before making a final decision so please keep a copy of your application for your reference.

How will I hear if my application has been successful?

We will write to you to tell you the outcome of your application. If you have been successful, you will be sent a conditional offer letter that will need signing and dating in order to agree to the terms and conditions of the grant before money will be released. You will also need to send the group's bank details in order for the grant to be paid into the bank account with the offer letter.
