

NOTICE OF ELECTION

PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION

FOR THE SOUTH WEST NORFOLK

CONSTITUENCY

- 1 An election is to be held of a Member to serve in Parliament for the said Constituency.
- 2 Forms of nomination may be obtained from the Acting Returning Officer at the Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk, King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
- 3 Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer (Office of the Deputy Acting Returning Officer, 2nd floor) at the Borough Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk, King's Court, Chapel Street, King's Lynn, PE30 1EX on any day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm but no later than **4 pm on Thursday, 11th May 2017.**
- 4 The deposit (£500) for each candidate may be paid by cash or bank transfer (bank details obtainable from the Acting Returning Officer).
- 5 If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 8th June 2017.**
- 6 New postal vote applications (including proxies applying to vote by post), changes or cancellations to existing postal, postal proxy or proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at either King's Court, Chapel Street, KING'S LYNN, PE30 1EX for electors in the King's Lynn and West Norfolk Borough Council area or Elizabeth House, Walpole Loke, DEREHAM, NR19 1EE for electors in the Breckland District Council area by **5 pm on Tuesday, 23rd May 2017.**
- 7 New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy) at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at either King's Court, Chapel Street, KING'S LYNN, PE30 1EX for electors in the King's Lynn and West Norfolk Borough Council area or Elizabeth House, Walpole Loke, DEREHAM, NR19 1EE for electors in the Breckland District Council area by **5 pm on Wednesday, 31st May 2017.**
- 8 Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election applied for on grounds of physical incapacity or for service/occupation or employment reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at King's Court, Chapel Street, KING'S LYNN, PE30 1EX for electors in the King's Lynn and West Norfolk Borough Council area or Elizabeth House, Walpole Loke, DEREHAM, NR19 1EE for electors in the Breckland District Council area by **5 pm on Thursday, 8th June 2017.** The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5 pm on Wednesday, 31st May 2017.** To apply on the grounds of service/occupation or employment reasons, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after **5 pm on Wednesday, 31st May 2017.**
