

Mattishall Neighbourhood Plan PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The formal public consultation on the draft Mattishall Neighbourhood Plan is now well underway and will run until **Monday 8th January 2024.**

What is the Neighbourhood Plan?

This is a community-led document to guide future development within the parish up to 2036. The plan must be used by Breckland District Council when making decisions on planning applications.

Why is it being reviewed?

The plan is now more than five years old and is being comprehensively reviewed and updated to ensure it reflects the views of the local community. The revised plan includes a guide to help inform the design on new development as well as proposals to safeguard our green spaces and protect our heritage.

How will my views be heard?
