- 11. Is Policy HOU 03 justified and consistent with national policy?
- 12. Is Policy HOU 04 justified and consistent with national policy? (Please can the Council have particular regard to criteria 1, 2 and 3)
- 13. Is Policy HOU 05 justified and consistent with national policy? (Please can the Council have particular regard to criteria 2, 3 and 5)
- 14. What are the exceptional circumstances referred to in Policy HOU 05?
