**BRECKLAND LOCAL PLAN

(ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012:
INDEPENDENT EXAMINATION
(REGULATION 24)**

The Secretary of State has appointed Jonathan Manning BSc (Hons) MA MRTP of the Planning Inspectorate to conduct the independent Examination of the Breckland Local Plan to establish whether it is sound.

A series of Hearings were conducted between April - June 2018 resulting in the Council submitting additional documents to the Inspector on 29th June 2018 to inform the consideration of particular Matters and Issues.

The Inspector will conduct a further series of Hearings to discuss the additional work and related proposed modifications submitted by the Council. Those that made a written representation on the Pre-Submission Publication of the Local Plan have been invited to participate. The Hearing sessions will start on Tuesday 18th September 2018 and end Thursday 20th September with a reserve session on Friday 21st September. The Hearing sessions will be held at the Council's Offices in the Committee Suite, Elizabeth House, Dereham, Norfolk, NR19 1EE.
